The American Red Cross Small Craft Safety: Moving Water certification is valid for three years. Participants will learn safety guidelines when canoeing on a river and basic moving water paddling strokes. This training is intended for individuals associated with youth organizations, such as the American Camp Association and Girl Scouts of the USA.
